Dear SVHOA Homeowner,

The Board of the Secluded Valley Homeowner's Association adopted this Architectural Project Guide to Assist Homeowners understand and comply with the requirements that govern our Association concerning Construction, Modification or Change-of-Status Projects on their property.

The Guide is Easy-to-Follow and provides a one-stop compendium of the applicable areas over which our Association has jurisdiction. It is structured for the Homeowner to fully describe their proposed project. If necessary, it also provides the Homeowner an opportunity to meet with the Architectural Committee to clarify any questions under consideration before it renders a decision. The Committee of three must render a project decision by majority rule. If the Architectural Committee fails to approve the project, the Homeowner may request the project be referred to the entire Board for a final decision. There is a great effort to work with each Homeowner and render a decision in a timely and expeditious manner.

Under CC&R's the SVHOA should be the first step in any proposed project. In many cases it will be the only necessary step. By working with the SVHOA Board, if the project is approved, it may provide the homeowner with greater leverage should any other Public Agency approval be needed for finalization.

Should any proposed project be constructed without SVHOA approval, or without any applicable Public Agency permit and approval, it could very well result in a requirement that the project be removed or torn down. Shortcuts clearly place those projects in great jeopardy. PLEASE DON'T LET THIS HAPPEN TO YOU!

As your SVHOA Board we are here to assist you through this process. What you need to do is simply take the first step whenever a project is being proposed and follow the SVHOA Guide and Application process. The President of the Homeowner's Association will be happy to review the Guide & Application Process with you in detail. This process should speed your proposed project to a reality sooner, rather than later.

SECLUDED VALLEY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION (SVHOA) INSTRUCTIONAL GUIDE FOR HOMEOWNER PROJECTS

PART I

A. <u>BACKGROUND</u>: In April 1973, the Secluded Valley Homeowner's Association Articles of Incorporation was originally filed by the builder and certified by the State of California. In March 1981, the Secluded Valley Homeowners Association Board of Directors was formed and the CC &R's and By-Laws became legal binding documents for all SVHOA homeowners. Later, the State of California enacted Governing Laws such as the Davis-Stirling Act, which imposed additional legal conditions on Homeowner Associations. This law generally overrides any conflicting provisions within our Governing Documents. Since SVHOA is located within Contra Costa County, the County's Building Codes and procedures are also applicable for projects that are within their jurisdiction. Additionally, approvals may be required by the City of Lafayette for homes within its boundaries.

B. HOMEOWNER REQUIREMENTS: SVHOA CC &R ARTICLE VI states: "No buildings, fence or other structure shall be commenced, executed or maintained upon the properties, nor shall exterior addition to or change or alteration therein be made until the plans and specifications showing the nature, kind, shape, height, material, colors and locations of the same shall have been submitted to and approved in writing as to harmony of external design and location in relation to surrounding structures and topography by the Board of Directors of the Association, or by an architectural committee composed of three or more representatives appointed by the Board. In the event said board, or its designated committee, fails to approve or disapprove such design and location with thirty (30) days after said plans and specifications have been submitted to it, approval will not be required and this Article will be deemed to have been fully complied with. No fence or wall shall be erected, placed or altered on any lot nearer to any street than the minimum building setback line unless similarly approved. Nothing in this article shall preclude the requirement for meeting all applicable government codes."

C. PROCEDURAL STEP BY STEP GUIDE: To provide further clarity, a Guide for assisting the homeowners has been developed to assist the homeowners to determine if any proposed project falls within the scope of SVHOA or any other regulatory agency. The guide provides assistance as an aid, if you are constructing, changing or modifying your property. The Guide will help to sort through the compliance issues with applicable codes, laws and restrictions. The Guide will be further updated as any new factors become pertinent or germane to our Association. When submitted, the Architectural Project Application is a written Legal Contract and therefore time must be taken to carefully complete the application with thoughtfulness and deliberation.

- 3. NEW WINDOWS, REPLACEMENTS FOR EXISTING WINDOWS, SIDING, OR DOORS
- **4. ROOF REPLACEMENT (Under certain conditions)**
- 5. FENCING
- 6. RECOLORING THE EXTERIOR SURFACES
- 7. EXTERIOR HARDSCAPING
- **8. EXTERIOR LIGHTING: Under certain conditions)**
- 9. LANDSCAPING: (Under certain conditions)
- 10. ANTENNAE

AN EASY-TO- COMPLETE HOMEOWNER/PROPERTY CHANGE OF STATUS SVHOA APPLICATION FORM

An easy-to-complete Change of Status Application Form is provided for all homeowners to utilize, whenever a project under the jurisdiction of the SVHOA is proposed. Once completed, the application needs to be forwarded by mail or email to your SVHOA Board PRIOR to any commencement of the project. Once the Board/Architectural Committee receives a fully complete application, the homeowner will be notified. Action by the Architectural Committee will be prompt. However, if questions are raised by the project and the Architectural Committee is not unanimous in its decision, the project will then be submitted to the entire SVHOA Board. If the full Board were needed, it would be at the next regular meeting, or if the 30-day time limit would be exceeded, an emergency meeting would be called. If, for any reason, the time exceeds 30 days, which starts from the date of receipt of the complete application, then by our governing documents, the project would be automatically deemed approved.

It should be noted that SVHOA APPROVAL DOES NOT SUPERSEDE any other applicable agency such as CONTRA COSTA COUNTY or THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE as well as their building codes and permit processes. The Homeowner MUST SEEK and GAIN APPROVAL FROM ALL APPLICABLE AGENCIES PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF ANY PROJECT. If the permit process is not followed, then the County, City of Lafayette or other public agencies may require the project to be torn down and removed, especially if a project requiring a permit was constructed without a legal permit.

THE GOOD NEWS IS PROJECTS FALLING SOLELY WITHIN SVHOA JURISDICTION, A DECISION WILL BE PROMPT AND TIMELY. By planning ahead, it will streamline the process to assist you with your compliance obligations. Additionally, having obtained SVHOA approval will both help and benefit your project if you are required to seek any other public agency approval. The Architectural Committee will make every attempt to fair, thorough, impartial and expeditious.
